Here are the necessary No Parking changes on North 10th St., North Water St., Menasha Ave. and Wisconsin Ave. that will be required due to the conversion of 10th and 11th Streets to 2-Way Traffic:

Can you please put an item on the March Public Safety Committee Agenda for these changes?

1. **Create a new section for No Parking on the northeast side of North Water Street beginning at the north curb line of Park St. extended west and continuing northwest for a distance of 200 feet.**
2. **Create a new section for No Parking on the east side of North 10th Street beginning at the east crosswalk line of North Water St. and continuing north for a distance of 95 feet.**
3. **Create a new section for No Parking on the west side of North 10th Street beginning at the east crosswalk line of North Water St. and continuing north for a distance of 45 feet.**
4. **Create a new section for No Parking on the northeast side of Menasha Ave. beginning at the west curb line (extended south towards Wisconsin Ave.) of North 11th St. and continuing northwest for a distance of 70 feet.**
5. **Create a new section for No Parking on the southwest side of Menasha Ave. beginning at the west curb line (extended south towards Wisconsin Ave.) of North 11th St. and continuing northwest for a distance of 70 feet.**
6. **Create a new section for No Parking on the north side of Wisconsin Avenue beginning at the west curb line of North 11th St. and continuing west for a distance of 50 feet.**
