Sometimes we would drive past at 1 pm in the afternoon many hours before the shelter was open. These people had to sit outside hours a day just to get a bed. Once a week my son who is 8 years old and I would stop, we would bring several things to people. We have done food, hand warmers, blankets, and some crafts for them to do. Every single one of them were grateful and we always had one lady who asked to give me and my son a hug. This is not just a one off thing that happened for us this is a everyday thing. Having to turn someone away is difficult. Having to explain to a 8 year old boy that there is nothing more I can do to help these people is sad. We need options for these people.

As a community we need to come together. We need to help those who need help, we never know if it could be us. We simply do not have enough resources to help with affordable housing in Manitowoc.
