**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY REPAIRS  
TO MANITOWOC AQUATIC CENTER POOL**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Manitowoc owns and is responsible for maintenance of the Manitowoc Aquatic Center; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Aquatic Center Pool has experienced a break in the five inch water supply line underneath the shallow end of the pool; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Department of Public Infrastructure Building and Grounds Division has excavated the area and located the supply line break; and

**WHEREAS**, failure to repair the water supply line break before frost sets in the ground would cause additional damage to the structure of the pool and result in additional costly repairs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Public Infrastructure and the Building and Grounds Division Manager have recommended taking immediate action to repair the water supply line break to prevent further damage and costly repairs to the pool; and,

**WHEREAS**, Wis. Stat. §62.15(1b) authorizes waiving of public bidding requirements for the repair and reconstruction of public facilities when determined by resolution that the damage or threatened damage creates an emergency in which the public health or welfare of the City of Manitowoc is endangered.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the City of Manitowoc Board of Public Works declares the repair to the water supply line for the Manitowoc Aquatic Center Pool to be an emergency in which the public health and welfare is endangered unless prompt action is taken.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of Public Works authorizes the proper City officials to waive bids for the necessary repair work to prevent further damage to the Manitowoc Aquatic Center Pool. The costs of the necessary emergency repair work at the Manitowoc Aquatic Center shall be made available from the City's capital projects funds.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Finance Director Steve Corbeille and Director of Public Infrastructure Dan Koski are authorized to sign any contracts necessary to effect


repair work at the Manitowoc Aquatic Center Pool, and shall forward those contracts on to the Common Council to be properly preserved in the public record.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution shall remain in effect until the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc determine by majority vote that the emergency no longer exists, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §62.15(1b).
