RE: RESOLUTION FOR ORNAMENTAL LIGHTING - YORK STREET AND MARITIME DRIVE

Dear Adam,

Enclosed is a resolution and map to order the installation of twenty-nine (29) each, ornamental, Double-Acorn, LED street light standards and remove eleven (11) ornamental, Cobra, LED street light standards to illuminate a section of York Street and Maritime Drive. MPU seeks Common Council approval for the installation per Municipal Code 12.150 and current rates provided by the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin.

Fiscal Impact- given 0% city contribution toward initial installation cost (\$232,244.18 estimated) LED Removals

170.50 per month fixed charge (15.50 per lamp/month x 11 lamps) plus 27.12 per month energy = 2,371.44 annual total.

LED Installations

1,160 per month fixed charge (10 per lamp/month x 58 lamps) plus 45.76 per month energy = 14,469.10 annual total.

WHEREAS, City of Manitowoc deems it desirable to install an ornamental lighting system along York Street and Maritime Drive, and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code 12.150(2)(a) defines ornamental street lighting as a type of lamp that is mounted to a standard or post to which energy is supplied from an underground electrical distribution system or from fixtures of special ornamental design, and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code 12.150(2)(b) provides that the Common Council may, by resolution, without petition, provide for the installation of an ornamental lighting system, and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code 12.150(2)(c) provides that the installation cost may be paid by the property owners or by the City at its discretion, and

WHEREAS, the Manitowoc Public Utilities proposes to provide for the City's share of the installation cost of the LED street lighting, estimated at \$232,244.18; recovering this cost through utility rates approved by the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Manitowoc Public Utilities estimates the annual street lighting expense charged to the City for this section of roadway will increase from \$2,371.44 to \$14,469.10, and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code 12.150(2)(d) provides that the operation and maintenance expenses of the ornamental street lighting system are to be paid from the City's general fund to the Manitowoc Public Utilities according to rates approved and on file with the Wisconsin Public Service Commission, and

WHEREAS, Manitowoc Public Utilities recommends installing twenty-nine (29) each, 40-Watt, Double-Acorn, ornamental, LED street lighting standards to provide lighting consistent with ANSI RP-8, American National Standard Practice for Roadway Lighting and removing eleven (11) each, 125-Watt Cobra, LED street lighting standards.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANITOWOC, that Manitowoc Public Utilities install and maintain twentynine (29) each, 40-Watt, Double Acorn, ornamental LED street light standards, and remove eleven (11) each, 125-Watt Cobra, LED street lighting standards along York Street and Maritime Drive.
