Conditions for Special Event Permit

\	At least 30 days prior to your event, in accordance with City policy, please have your insurance agent submit a certificate of insurance along with separate additional insured endorsement to my office to evidence your organization's liability insurance coverage. To expedite, please fax to 920-686-6959 or e-mail to mreedkadow@manitowoc.org . Special Events Insurance Requirements are also enclosed. If beer or wine is being served, you will need to provide liquor liability in the amount of \$500,000 each occurrence and \$500,000 aggregate. If you have a bounce house on City property, coverage must state it specifically covers bounce house. Insurance not provided within the required timeline may result in a fee of \$300
	Please bring your tavern license to the City Clerk's office prior to your event to have the extended premises added to your license.
	City policy allows for the extension of a licensed premises to include an outside area, with the understanding that the entire area will be completely fenced in with access through the door of your premises or through the gate of the fenced-in area only. Alcoholic beverages can only be consumed inside the premises and in the fenced-in area. Please contact the Chief of Police at 686-6573 to arrange details for fencing the licensed area.
X	A non-profit or bona fide club may apply for a Temporary Class "B" license for the beer stand in the City Clerk's Office in City Hall. A licensed bartender must be at the premise at all times.

All insurance for special events is required to be primary coverage and any insurance or self-insurance maintained by the City of Manitowoc, its officers, Council members, agents, employees, or authorized volunteers will not contribute to a loss. All insurance shall be in full force prior to commencing the event and remain in full force throughout the entire event, including the clean up period after the event.

The City of Manitowoc and its officers, Council members, agents, employees, and authorized volunteers shall be listed as Additional Insured on General Liability Coverage, Comprehensive Automobile Coverage and Umbrella Coverage. An Additional Insured Policy endorsement must accompany the Certificate of Insurance. PLEASE NOTE: this is a separate document from the certificate of insurance.

A copy of the certificate of insurance must be on file with the City Clerk at least 10 days prior to the event occurring. The City of Manitowoc requires 30 day written notice of cancellation, non-renewal or material change in the insurance coverage. The insurance coverage must be provided by an admitted carrier in the State of Wisconsin.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

(a) For insurance purposes, there are three classes of events: Large Events, Medium Events, and Small Events. Each class has its own characteristics. The City reserves the right to make a final determination of the event's classification and the related insurance requirements that will be

imposed upon the event organizer.

i. Large Events: Any event requiring a street closure in the area bounded by Marshall Street on the South, Lake Michigan on the East, State Street on the North, and 10th Street north of the Manitowoc River and Franklin Street south of the River on the west (shown on Exhibit B) or any event whose attendance is anticipated to be greater than 5,000 people, events with amusement devices, pony rides, bleachers used to seat more than 5,000 people or fireworks displays. This category includes, but is not limited to, parades, concerts, bike races, auto shows, circuses, and sidewalk sales.

ii. Medium Events: Any event whose attendance is expected to draw between 250 and 5,000 people. This category includes but is not limited to parades, concerts, dances or shows.

iii. Small Events: Any event expected to draw less than 250 people. This category includes, but is not limited to, block parties, plays, private gatherings in parks, or similar events.

Hi Sandy and committee

I have some information listed below to help with social distancing and clarify some of the steps we are taking. I spoke with Chief Blazer this mourning as well.

In our original application we had said alcohol would be served. We have since decided not to go ahead with that as part of this year tournament.

This is a pool play tournament. Each pool usually has 4 teams in it and based on the record in that pool they get seated in the single elimination tournament. Therefore we will be eliminating teams as the tournament progresses.

Pool games and time limits are 1:15 with no new inning starting after that. It's not a drop dead time so we plan 1:25 from the last start time. This allows for field prep and teams to leave and next teams to arrive.

At MYBA we are using 2 of the 4 diamonds. We are doing this for the incoming teams to warm up and social distance from other teams. At Lincoln and Westfield we will use the extra space in the outfield for this. The current permanent fence is 275 feet. The temporary fence put in from the city is 200 feet which will give those parks the same space for warm up and social distance. We are also told we could use a field at cp and this could help us move the tournament along even more efficiently.

A email will be sent to all teams regarding grandparents. We are encouraging them not to attend as they are considered high risk from CDC.

Concessions we are talking with Roncalli booster club to run them as a third party. We are only serving pretty packaged drinks and chips to limit lines and congregating while eating forcing teams to eat off site at restaurants or hotel rooms. We aren't serving any food or ice cream or such. We are telling concessions to wear masks and gloves.

Umpires will be directed to announce before the game as a public service announcement to remember social distancing and was hands. MYBA we will look to utilize the sound system.

Safety plan. Contact 911 for emergencies. We will encourage in a weather situation to take cover in there cars.

Masks can be worn by players but not required. The mask rule is a national federation rule that doesnt allow pitchers to wear flashy colors. Must be neutral color. The reason behind it is the bright color can distract the batter from batting and cause injury. This is especially true with colors yellow or red as it is the same color as the ball.

The teams that come to our tournament are mostly all long standing teams that have played in the tournament for the last 10 years.

In our rules, teams must carry hand sanitizer and we will also have hand sanitizer stations around.

I know last year we had run out of toilet paper. Just wanted to see how to go about that for restocking.
