Statement on Resolution 20-0283: Resolution to backfill two positions and 1 FTE overlap in the Fire/Rescue Department.

March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020

I am choosing to sign this resolution rather than veto it because the City of Manitowoc has budgeted for 51 full-time firefighters. As a result of retirements during 2020, both in the past and upcoming, the City will not have 51 firefighters at some points over the next few months. It is efficient for the City to train new firefighters at the same time. There are two vacancies now and an upcoming retirement, so I am signing this resolution to allow the Fire Chief to minimize the impact of onboarding new firefighters on Fire Department operations. While the City will briefly exceed the amount of firefighters budgeted for, the net impact at the end of the year will be budget-neutral.

The policy of the City of Manitowoc at this time if that there are 51 firefighters budgeted. Due to the many circumstances that have and will arise over the next few months, this minor adjustment to our regular policies will be made.

If the scheduled retirements do not occur as planned, adjustments will be made to staff to ensure only 51 firefighters are on the city payroll for the remainder of 2020 and beyond.

## RESOLUTION

## **FIREFIGHTERS**

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has submitted a request to backfill two vacant Firefighter positions, plus one additional Firefighter due to an anticipated planned retirement effective September 12, 2020, which would enable the start of recruit class with all three new hires for time and training purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Committee at a meeting held on February 10th, 2020, and the Personnel Committee at a meeting held on March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020, approved backfilling the two vacant Firefighter positions, and the overlap of one FTE Firefighter position for training purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council has enacted a resolution requiring 2/3 approval of the Common Council prior to filling a vacancy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc to approve backfilling the two vacant Firefighter positions, and the overlap of one FTE Firefighter position for training purposes, consistent with the City's Comprehensive Pay Plan within the Employee Policy Manual, and Fire collective bargaining agreements, which establish pay rates and benefits, all as approved in the Mayor's adopted 2020 Executive Budget.
