Schuette Park Community Built Playground Maintenance Project

The Manitowoc Parks Division is requesting the use of funds from the Restricted Schuette Park Playground Maintenance Fund (HSPLAYGR-DONTB) to pay for a maintenance project at the Community Built Playground.

In March we hired a consultant from *Play by Design* to come to Manitowoc to assess the current condition of the Community Built Playground. His assessment of the playground was that structurally, it was in pretty good shape, but a significant amount of the nonstructural wood could use replacement. Many of the metal balusters are rusting. Some are missing. The roofs of the playground structures have holes and are rotting. There is other, nonstructural wood rot. The rubber wood chips are also migrating downhill and could use more in certain areas.

We are requesting funds, not to exceed \$37,885.81 for this maintenance project. This project includes hiring three consultants for 3 days from *Play by Design*, purchasing and installing new recycled plastic handrails and balusters, replacing roofs on playground structures, painting/staining, and adding more rubber woodchips. Our hope is that this could extend the life of the playground 5-10 years allowing planning for future replacement. Currently, replacement costs using the Community Build Model would be in the \$500,000 range.

This maintenance project will be done in conjunction with volunteer help in painting and light-duty construction.

We recommend the City accepting this proposal for following reasons:

The Community Built Playground was constructed in 2003 and is nearing the end of its
projected life. There are significant issues with wood deterioration and we are looking
toward the future of the park. Completing this maintenance project would improve the
functionality, safety, and appearance of the playground and hopefully extend the life
with minimal further maintenance 5-10 years.




PROPOSAL

Working with the City of Manitowoc Parks, Play By Design LLC (hereafter called PBD) will assist in renovating the Community Playground at Henry Schuette Park. PBD will provide project management services, construction consultation, building materials, tools list, and material take-off. The City of Manitowoc will provide hardware, tools, and all volunteer labor for the playground renovation.

The play area will be designed in accordance with all ASTM and CPSC guidelines and safety standards for public playgrounds, as well as the requirements of ADAAG (Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines).

TASK TO BE PERFORMED

- Replacing all handrails on platforms 40" above surfacing with 2x2 balusters and 2x6 structural plastic rails.
- Replacing all handrails on platforms under 40" with 2x6 structural plastic and 2x4 guardrails.
- Replacing all handrail posts (dog eared 2x4s).
- All ramp rails and guardrails on ADA landings will not be replaced.
- The City of Manitowoc Parks staff with the assistance of volunteers will sand and stain structure, remove rails and pipe balusters, and install new rails and balusters under the supervision of PBD.
- Minimum of 7-10 skilled workers, in addition to unskilled labor to assist PBD for a duration of 5 days.
- PBD will assist the City of Manitowoc Parks to identify potential hazards throughout the play structure and remedy them during the 5 days of construction (additional materials may need to be purchased locally).





PROFESSIONAL FEES \$9,300

Includes:

- · Material take-off
- Building Materials
- Project management
- 2 construction consultants for 3 days (12 hrs/day), 1 PBD carpenter for 3 days (12 hrs/day)
- Reimbursement of travel and lodging. PBD estimated about \$3,000, includes flights, car rental, hotel accommodations, travel time expense (hotel accommodations are typically donated).
