Hi Chad,

I looked into the two companies you told me about and that you use. These two companies look like they only make playground equipment for kids, nothing for agility courses. I had Jerrod (my husband) call a couple of the companies who sell the dog agility equipment we were looking at. He found a retailer here in Wisconsin (see his email below) who is willing to work with us. He was pretty excited about our students' project and wanted to give us a deal. He gave us the quote for the intermediate dog park equipment I had shared with you earlier. His quote includes the equipment and the freight. The total came to \$5,717. After Jerrod looked at the installation directions, we will need an additional \$298 for cement, pavers, and a cement mixer (rental fee). So the total comes to \$6,015.

Our students have a gift card to Menards for \$200 (we will be using this towards the pavers and cement). That being said our total comes down to \$5,815. Our students have raised a total of \$2583.74 (this doesn't include the \$200 gift card). Bank First National contacted me and said they were planning on sending a check for \$200 this week. We also have two final fundraisers the kids will be finishing up by Mar. 24th. They are smaller fundraisers and I don't anticipate them bringing in a ton of funding. They are selling t-shirts one more time and we are offering families a chance to purchase photo prints of two collages we made for the art auction. That being said, we should have \$2,783.74 for sure by the end of the upcoming week. If we base what we need off of these numbers, we would need \$3,031.26 from the Parkland Dedication Funds. I have a feeling though it may be less than \$3,000 after we finish our last two fundraisers. So, we are very close to the numbers I had originally anticipated. Let me know if you need anything else from me or if you need me to meet with the board again. I would be happy to do that too.
