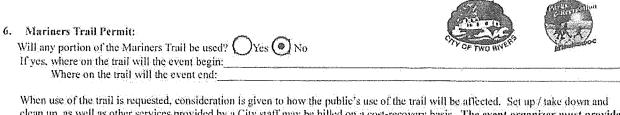

In the event this Limitation of Use is not complied with, Permittee shall be charged and agrees to pay a fee of \$200.

Regarding item #5.

The purpose of the event is for amateur radio operators to set up a portable radio station, antenna, and portable power supply and then make contacts throughout the United States and Canada with other amateur radio operators. A large part of amateur radio is providing back-up emergency communications to various government and non-government agencies. Lakeshore Amateur Radio Service Club's mission is for volunteer amateur radio operators to provide emergency communications to the local Nuclear Power Plants, Red Cross, Holy Family Memorial Hospital, and the City and County of Manitowoc Emergency Operations for Public Safety. We achieve this mission by providing voice, digital and email communications via radio frequency. We also have the capabilities to set up mobile and portable stations, as well as, provide real-time tracking of assets and resources. This event, Field Day, encourages amateur radio operators to practice for such situations by getting us out of our home stations and operating in the field.

The antennas that will be used are of various types. Wire antennas are usually hung from trees, vertical antennas are placed on tripods, and directional antennas can be used as well, in various configurations. None of the antennas will cause any permanent change to the environment or local vegetation.

Camping on-site provides an opportunity to operate into the late evening, and even overnight, when often times propagation is ideal for making distant contacts. It also helps the operators who participate, so they don't have to set up and then take down equipment, just to return the next day to set-up again.

Other than parking personal vehicles, we will not be using the parking lot. And we will stay clear of the disc golf course, so as to not interfere with game play.

Regarding security and medical emergencies, 911 will be used.

Regarding food and drink, nothing will be for sale, and only available for club members participating in the event. The public is welcome to ask questions, look at the radios and set-up, and even participate with the help of a radio operator. We are volunteers, and there are no fees or items for sale associated with our event.

I hope this provides the information you asked for, and I am more than happy to help with any additional questions.
