I explained to her that we want to adjust the pond outlet structure to reduce the flow out of the pond, but we have to balance that so that we do not have the pond overtopping the banks in the large storm events. The adjustment has not taken place yet, but we hope to do it soon. However, we may not know how it is functioning until next spring or summer. We will need to get a very heavy rain event to see if this adjustment helps.

I told her that I would request this item to be on the Sept. 4th PI Committee Meeting agenda to see if the Committee is O.K. with installing the warning signage.

I am hoping that lowering the gate by 1" will help with the trestle flooding issue. However, this will increase the water elevation in the pond, but I believe that there is capacity within the pond to store the additional stormwater without overtopping the banks of the pond.

In addition, I would like the opening height to be reduced by 1 inch. The gate is currently set with a 6 inch opening. I would like the gate to be set to an opening of 5 inches.

I would like to monitor the pond elevations during storms and also see if this helps to reduce flooding under the RR bridge.

Please let us know when these changes are made so that we can begin monitoring the pond and the roadway during storms. Thanks.

Uriah,

Attached are the drawings and pictures for the storm Gate MH # L14-147 & MH # L14-148.

A block diversion wall will not work in the 4 foot diameter manhole L14-148, there is not enough room between the two 36" diameter pipes east/west. With the pipe thickness of the future 24" to the north we would have to cut out some of the 36" concrete pipes east/west to slide it in..... could be done.

I was thinking about maybe a 5 foot high (field fabricated) metal plate instead of the block diversion wall. But the contractor would have to take the cone section off to fit the metal plate down the manhole and somehow fasten the plate to the rounded part of the manhole. Just a thought.....

The measurements of the slide gate manhole are on the 1994 plan sheet.

Any questions let me know.
I will be back in Monday morning.
