**RESOLUTION**

**WASTEWATER INTERIM SUPERINTENDENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Superintendent has tendered his resignation effective December 16, 2017; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Manitowoc is required to have a Wisconsin DNR-certified Wastewater Operator to be the Operator-in-Charge and signatory to Discharge Monitoring Reports, Biosolids Land Application reports, and all other WPDES permit required reporting; and,

**WHEREAS**, under Manitowoc Municipal Code § 3.100(3) the Wastewater Treatment Facility Board recommends to Common Council a candidate for Superintendent; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Wastewater Treatment Facility Board recommends Michael Jaeger to assume the Superintendent duties on an interim basis, and further recommends increasing his salary to \$72,026.24 (\$34.63 per hour, 10% increase of his current salary) until such time that a permanent Superintendent is appointed.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY** Mayor Justin M. Nickels and the Common Council of the City of Manitowoc that the position of Wastewater Superintendent is to be filled by Michael Jaeger on an interim basis in accordance with the Mayor's adopted 2016/2017 Executive Budget and his salary shall be set at \$72,026.24.
