Hello Erich,

I wanted to give you an update on the ships wheel monument. Here is what I have so far. Take a look and see if you think that I am missing anything. TJ Seiler was the cheapest I found for concrete, unless you made any progress with Martell. I also talked with Irv Seiler and Vinton.

One hurdle that we need to get past first though is covering the cost. Initially I thought that we could cover the concrete and steel, however the council ended up approving it with using zero budgeted city funds. So we need to know who will cover the cost of the materials and TJ's labor before we can start. I would suggest using your industry contacts and sell spots on the plaque for names of people or businesses. Maybe \$1,000 for 2" letters, \$500 for 1" and \$250 for 1/2", this is just a thought? I can't commit too much time to this, even though I would like to. I have permission from my boss and the mayor to help you get it up, but to spend minimal time on it. If I can make any contacts through daily ops I will try to help get more donors. As soon as we agree that all areas are covered we should start setting some dates for work to start.
