Comprehensive Plan: The Future 20 Year Land Use Map shows the area as General Business and Planned Neighborhood.

Consistency Analysis

When the update to the Comprehensive Plan is taking place in 2021 the Future Land Use Map will be amended to reflect the City's plans for the property.

Report: On March 24, 2020 the City of Manitowoc purchased approximately 87.2 acres from Manitowoc County (quit claim deed Volume 3282 Page 373). The actual area to be annexed will be 92.91 acres which includes the right-of-way areas in Hecker Road, Viebahn and W. Viebahn Streets. The City's general goal with the property is for a future business and industrial park. The property is located south of Viebahn and West Viebahn Streets, and east and west of Hecker Road. There are 51.25 acres east of Hecker Road and 35.95 acres west of Hecker Road. The property abuts the west right-of-way line of I-43. Wetlands are located at the southeast corner of the property east of Hecker Road and along the east property line of the property that is west of Hecker Road.

Pursuant to Wis. § 62.0223 "Annexation of territory owned by a City or Village", a City, by adoption of an Ordinance can annex property under their ownership. No public hearings or annexation petition is required under § 62.0223. Pursuant to Municipal Code 15.050(5) the

property will be classified at R-1 Residential-Agricultural District. In the future the City will go through a formal rezoning process and amendment to the Future Land Use Map to reflect the future development for the property.

This annexation will connect the current city limits with the City of Manitowoc gravel pit area, which is currently not contiguous with the City Limits proper. The City will not have to pay the Town of Newton 5 years of property taxes because the property was tax exempt because it was under County ownership. In addition the City does not need to pay any Wis. Department of Administration review fees.

Currently the City does not have any concept plans for the property but generally purchased the property for future industrial and business uses. At this time no utility or street plans have been developed. The City will also dedicate, to itself the right-of-ways for Hecker Road, Viebahn and W. Viebahn Streets.

ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to annex certain territory from the Town of Newton to the City of Manitowoc as part of the 9th Aldermanic District and the 17th, 18th 21st, 23rd, 24th, 25th 26th and 28th Wards of the City.

WHEREAS, the petition to annex the territory described below has been filed with the City of Manitowoc; and

WHEREAS, the petition meets the requirements of Wisconsin Statute Section 66.0223; and

WHEREAS, the Manitowoc Common Council has determined that the City has reasonable need for the property and it is in the best interest of the petitioners, the residents and owners of property in the area to be annexed and the City of Manitowoc to annex the property to the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Territory Annexed. Pursuant to Wisconsin Statute Section 66.0223, the following described territory in the Town of Newton, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin is hereby annexed to the City of Manitowoc:

DESCRIPTION

A tract of land located in the NW ¼ of the NE ¼, in the SW ¼ of the NE ¼ and in the NE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 2, T. 18N., R. 23E., Town of Newton, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin described as follows:

Commencing at the North ¼ corner of said Section 2, the point of real beginning, thence N89°43′17″E (recorded as N88°26′27″E) along the section line 70.30 feet to the South ¼ corner of Section 35, T.19N., R.23E., thence N89°53′18″E (recorded as N88°26′27″E) along the section line 1005.13 feet to the west right of way of I-43, thence S30°28′55″E (recorded as S32°09′53″E) along said right of way 87.90 feet to a point on a 3629.72 foot radius right of way curve to the right, thence southeasterly along the arc of said curve 1067.77 feet (chord S10°34′57″E 1063.93 feet (recorded as S12°15′55″E)) to the east line of said NW ¼ of the NE ¼ and the SW ¼ of the SW ¼ of the NE ¼ also being the west right of way of I-43, thence S00°57′04″W (recorded as S00°43′51″E) 708.21 feet, thence S87°43′33″W 1332.78 feet to the ¼ section line, thence N00°51′15″E along said ¼ section line 633.90 feet to the south line of said NE ¼ of the NW ¼, thence S88°30′34″W along said south line 1322.16 feet to the west line of said NE ¼ of the NW ¼, thence N89°43′17″E along said west line 1278.40 feet to said section line, thence N89°43′17″E along said section line 1326.72 feet to the point of real beginning.

Said tract contains 92.91 acres (4,047,020 square feet).

SECTION 2. Aldermanic District and Ward. The territory herein described is made part of the 9th Aldermanic District and 32nd Ward of the City of Manitowoc:

SECTION 3. Zone District Classification. The territory annexed is classified as "R-1" Residential - Agricultural, all according to the attached map.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the Manitowoc Common Council did annex territory (Hecker #3 Annexation Area), and

WHEREAS an Attorney General's opinion has indicated that districts set by reapportionment are not changed by annexation in regards to voting,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City of Manitowoc creates Ward Number 32, population zero (0), for the Hecker #3 Annexation Area and provides the following boundary description:

DESCRIPTION

A tract of land located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, T. 18N., R. 23E., Town of Newton, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin described as follows:

Commencing at the North $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 2, the point of real beginning, thence N89°43'17"E (recorded as N88°26'27"E) along the section line 70.30 feet to the South $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 35, T.19N., R.23E., thence N89°53'18"E (recorded as N88°26'27"E) along the section line 1005.13 feet to the west right of way of I-43, thence S30°28'55"E (recorded as S32°09'53"E) along said right of way 87.90 feet to a point on a 3629.72 foot radius right of way curve to the right, thence southeasterly along the arc of said curve 1067.77 feet (chord S10°34'57"E 1063.93 feet (recorded as S12°15'55"E)) to the east line of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ also being the west right of way of I-43, thence S00°57'04"W (recorded as S00°43'51"E) 708.21 feet, thence S87°43'33"W 1332.78 feet to the $\frac{1}{4}$ section line, thence N00°51'15"E along said $\frac{1}{4}$ section line 633.90 feet to the south line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, thence S88°30'34"W along said south line 1322.16 feet to the west line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, thence N00°36'42"E along said west line 1278.40 feet to said section line, thence N89°43'17"E along said section line 1326.72 feet to the point of real beginning.


Said tract contains 92.91 acres (4,047,020 square feet).
