> Good afternoon Greg.

>

> We have been providing our collections in the alleys since 1957. To the best of my knowledge the hauler that provided collections in those areas also provided alley collections before us.

> The collections are being done this way because we have continued the service.

> I will provide our collections to my customers in the alleys or out to the street. If the City does not want heavy vehicle traffic driving through the alleys to provide service, then we will not go through the alleys. We will then provide our collections with our customers putting their garbage and recyclables out to the street at curbside.

> Would there be signs posted at the alley entries as not to allow heavy vehicle traffic?

> Just a thought. Would the City be notifying all those property owners that there will not be any heavy vehicle traffic allowed in the alleys such as garbage trucks, recycling trucks, moving/service trucks and even contractors and roofers? And also that all arrangements should be made with those providers if they are using heavy equipment that all work would need to be from the street, curbside?

> Changes on our end can be implemented immediately after the notification to the residence of the change in city ordinance/policy.
