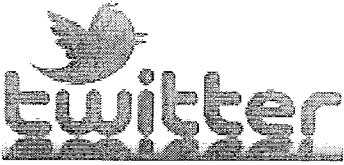

- 1) I talked to Tim. He has some very good points. He is on the pickup route, however he is one of those parcels that does not have a parking lane. For the past 3 years we have been and will continue to pick this area up on the second night of the storm. This in turn does not allow him to push his snow from his sidewalk the day after it snows, thus putting him in violation of the city ordinance for sidewalk snow removal. So he has taken it upon himself to haul all of his sidewalk snow away. So he is paying a contractor for that and the city for a service that he is not able to take advantage of. I didn't tell him that I would do anything about this other than pass the info on to other city officials. But maybe we need to look at this?
A simple solution would be allowing people 2 days to clear their sidewalks. The hard solution would be more people in plows. Many people including our department and city property has this happen the day after the storm already. So we have not always been complying with our own ordinance. Back when we had the Plowing VSM it was considered to close city owned ped walks to allow others to be plowed. It was decided that we couldn't close city sidewalks, but would plow them on the second day.

My opinion – bring it up at the DPI committee meeting.

- 2) Not sure who this was. I talked to the streets crews and we do hope to get back here later this week. They can't recall leaving a pile here specifically, but it could be some leaves that rolled off of the end of the tractor basket would be my guess. The crews are still concentrating on the bulk of the leaves and not raking every small pile into the bucket.
