Dan, per the U.S. Geological Survey and the Wisconsin DNR, the old hand pump at the former wayside near the Visitor Information Center is broken and needs to be removed to allow access for ground water measurement. I have received two estimates and am recommending that we hire Karl Kimmes Well & Pump, Inc. to remove said pump, extend the casing to 24" AFG, and install a locking well cover.
