



General Plow Report

Date(s) of GP:

3-6-18 @ 7am / Pickup 3-7-18 @ 12am

Hours of GP:

8hrs / Pickup 8hrs - Crew worked 10hrs w/ salt rts.

Amount & Description of Snowfall:

5" Wet heavy snow
 started falling @ 10pm on 3-5-18, ended @
 10pm on 3-6-18

Summary of Activities:

Snow started around 10pm on 3-5-18. All personnel was called in @ 3am on 3-6 for parking lots and Salt Routes. We plowed salt routes curb to curb then started a day general plow @ 7am. After side streets we plowed salt routes again curb to curb. Streets were looking good then and the crew went home to sleep around 4pm. We came back @ 12am to P.D. downtown. At that point it had snowed another 1" and roads were like ice. We shifted everyone that we could to salt routes while still continuing with downtown pickup. Almost all salt routes were salted by team.

Equipment Breakdowns:

- ① New blower had coolant fitting come loose so we switched to backup. Backup sheared a pin. (total downtime about 45 minutes to 1 hour).
- ② Salter #52 broken wing - repaired in 1hr.
- ③ Pickup #21 blew hyd. hose - down 1 hour
- ④ Tandem #73 blew a tire - down 1 hour

Ideas for Improvement:

- ① Keep anti-ice unit and employee working late the night prior to an event like this
- ② Don't plow gravel streets when they have started to thaw unless you absolutely need to.
- ③ Day plow was a must, or we would have had severe hard packs!
