I believe the biggest problem is the northbound 10th St. right turners onto Maritime Dr. coming flying around the corner on a green light.

There is no point putting any signage or lights on the existing utility pole that is just east of the intersection. No one will see it.

I will still stick with my first option which was a sign on 10th St. just south of the traffic signals stating "Caution Hidden Driveway on Maritime Dr." Or something to that extent.

We are really at a loss for any other suggestions.

For the issues with the RRFB at Schuette Park Pedestrian Crossing, I also already talked to Jared Kinzinger at the DOT and he referred me to Joanna Bush who is an expert on interconnected signals and knows about RRFB's as well. She works for Mead and Hunt. I did not get a chance to talk to her yet.
