



ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to amend Section 10.390 of the Manitowoc Municipal Code regulating Parking Prohibited.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 10.390 is amended to read as follows:

“10.390 Parking Prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to park such vehicle in any of the places where parking is prohibited by Wis. Stat. Ch. 346, except to comply with the directions of a traffic officer or traffic control signal or sign, or to park upon any portion of the following designated streets or places:

...

South 17th Street. There shall be no parking on South 17th Street as follows:

(a) ~~On the east side of South 17th Street from the south curblin~~ ~~of Washington Street, thence continuing south for a distance of 280 feet.~~

(b) ~~On the west side of South 17th Street beginning at a point located 100 feet south of the south curblin~~ ~~of Washington Street, thence continuing south to Marshall Street, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.~~

(e) (a) On the west side of South 17th Street beginning at a point located 15 feet south of the south curblin of Franklin Street, thence continuing south a distance of 52 feet, except for the sole purpose of loading or unloading motor vehicles.

(d) (b) On the west side of South 17th Street from the south curblin of Clark Street southerly for a distance of 116 feet.


