Allowing dogs in parks

## RECOMMENDATION:

- 1.) Allow dogs, on leashes, in all city parks or beaches. Ordinance 14.020(5)(a)
  - a. PARK EXCLUSIONS
    - i. Evergreen Cemetery
    - ii. School grounds (unless otherwise noted by the school)
    - iii. Citizen Park (entirety)
    - iv. Lincoln Park Zoo
  - b. EVENT EXCLUSIONS (events in/near parks)
    - i. Any special event as determined by the Special Events Committee
  - c. LEASHES
    - i. Current Ordinance 14.020(7) allows dogs on sidewalks, trails, etc. to have up to 8 feet
    - ii. Recommended: Lower to 6 feet (including retractable leashes)
    - iii. Invisible leashes would not be acceptable
  - d. BEACHES
    - i. No mention in current ordinance
    - ii. RECOMMENDATION: Allowed off leash at beaches
      - 1. EXCLUSION: Red Arrow and Blue Rail (must be leashed)
  - e. DESIGNATED DOG PARKS
    - i. No leash required
    - ii. Fines for defecation (not picking up) or attacking still apply

## f. FINES

- i. 14.020 (9) Defecation on Private and Public Property Prohibited
  - 1. Current: \$20 to \$200
  - 2. Recommended: \$200
- ii. 14.020 (12) Attacking or Biting Dog, Cat, or Other Creatures
  - 1. Current: \$50 to \$500
  - 2. Recommended: Remain the same
- iii. 14.202 (4)(d) Penalty for Dogs, Cats, and other Creatures not to run at large
  - 1. Current: \$40 to \$200
  - 2. Recommended: \$50 to \$500
  - 3. Recommended: Include "unleashed" in this category with a fine amount of \$200 set.
- 2.) Include in the 2018 budget dollars for signage in parks (exclusion only) and bags for waste.
- 3.) Ordinance to take effect Jan. 1, 2018 to allow for notification to citizens.
