Section 25.060 (2)(k)

Motion to amend to read as follows:

Section 1. Section 25.060 (2)(k) is amended to read as follows:

“(2) General Discharge Prohibitions. In addition to the prohibitions and limitations in MMC [25.040](#)(1)(g) and (h), the following substances shall not be introduced into the wastewater disposal system or otherwise to the facilities of the City:

(k) Any wastewater containing an average molybdenum concentration of greater than 0.10 mg/l, unless the industry discharge permit allows for a different concentration level ~~or a molybdenum mass loading of 0.10 lb./day, except that wastewater exceeding the concentration limit is permitted if the mass loading of molybdenum is less than 0.10 lb./day.~~ Measurements shall be taken over a 24-hour period or over the period of discharge, if such a discharge is less than 24 hours.”

ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to revise Section 25.060 of the Manitowoc Municipal Code regulating limits on molybdenum concentration in the City of Manitowoc.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 25.060 (2)(k) is amended to read as follows:

“(2) General Discharge Prohibitions. In addition to the prohibitions and limitations in MMC [25.040](#)(1)(g) and (h), the following substances shall not be introduced into the wastewater disposal system or otherwise to the facilities of the City:

(k) Any wastewater containing an average molybdenum concentration of greater than 0.10 mg/l, unless the industry discharge permit allows for a different concentration level or a molybdenum mass loading of 0.10 lb./day, ~~except that wastewater exceeding the concentration limit is permitted if the mass loading of molybdenum is less than 0.10 lb./day.~~ Measurements shall be taken over a 24-hour period or over the period of discharge, if such a discharge is less than 24 hours.”
