

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it is expedient and necessary and in the best interest of the City of Manitowoc that certain infrastructure improvements be included in the 2016 Public Works Program.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANITOWOC, that the work listed below be included in the 2016 Street Improvement, Sanitary and Storm Sewer, and Miscellaneous Program, and that the Board of Public Works is herewith authorized and instructed to prepare plans and specifications and advertise for bids for work on these streets and miscellaneous projects.

CONCRETE PAVING

1. Dewey Street – South 26th St. to 400 feet West of South 39th Street
2. North 6th Street – 350 feet North of Reed Ave. to 750 feet North of Reed Ave.
3. Fessler Drive – 550 feet East of S. Alverno Rd. to 900 feet East of S. Alverno Rd. (TIF 17)
4. Concrete Slab Replacement – Various Locations

ASPHALTIC CONCRETE RESURFACING AND OVERLAY

1. Alley #8A, 8B & 8C Bounded by Lincoln, North 8th St., Pine St. & Waldo Blvd.
2. Alley #16 Bounded by Michigan Ave., Prospect Ave., N. 19th & N. 20th St.
3. Spring Street – Huron Street to approx. 500 feet to the Southwest.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the abutting property will be assessed, per foot, per side, where applicable pursuant to the Wisconsin Statutes and the Municipal Code of the City of Manitowoc.
