Re: Lincoln Park Zoo Alpaca Acquisition Costs

The Lincoln Park Zoo has received a generous offer from a local resident to donate a family of 11 alpacas. After careful consideration staff and zoo society collectively would like to move forward with acquiring these animals.

The donor, Ron Nerring has also offered to sell the city necessary equipment to house the alpacas at a reduced rate. Staff is requesting permission to pull the necessary funds to purchase the equipment from the donation tube account. Below is a list of items and cost for equipment and hardware.
