Our Committee meeting is next week Tuesday the 27th. I will get it on that agenda. I would also like to run it by some other staff members first. I am still slightly concerned with the added maintenance for my crews. While it doesn't look like much on the surface, it will be an added location for my cutting and trimming crew to maintain. Right now that area is cut by 1 large tractor, with the agility course I will have to send three crews there weekly to cut vs. one. I think we can probably overcome this. I would like to see a group commit to adoption of the area once the course is installed (maybe the humane society, or just an area dog lover?). They would not need to cut grass, but would perform monthly checks/cleanup and a spring and fall cleanup (this could include spreading wood chips and weed control in spring/fall). You could also possibly solicit the area for neighborhood volunteers to adopt the course.

Don't get me wrong, I will definitely support the project. I just want to see what we can do up front to keep it in good condition in future years. Let me know your thoughts on this and we can move it forward.
