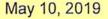

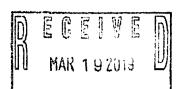

I further understand that an incomplete application may be cause for the denial of the event.

The undersigned agrees to indemnify and hold the City of Manitowoc harmless for any and all damage claims or personal injury claims occurring during this event. It is further agreed that all personal property of any kind brought on the premises shall be at the sole risk of the undersigned, and that the City of Manitowoc shall not be liable for any injury, loss or damage to said property or injury to any persons on the premises.
