

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DISCONTINUANCE OF A PORTION OF ARCHER STREET, IN THE INTEREST OF THE PUBLIC, PURSUANT TO WIS. STAT. 66.1003.

WHEREAS, the City of Manitowoc would like to vacate a portion of the following described street:

ARCHER STREET A street vacation in a tract of land located in the SE ¼ of the SE ¼ and in the SW ¼ of the SE ¼ of Section 23, T.19 N., R.23 E., City of Manitowoc, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin and described as follows:


Commencing at the southeast corner of Lot 16, Block 7, Manitowoc Rapids Subdivision; thence westerly along the south line of said Block 7 a distance of 501 feet more or less to the southwest corner of Lot 9, Block 7 also being on the east line of Tract 1A of a Certified Survey recorded Volume 5, Page 215; thence S. 3° 29' W. along the east line of said Tract a distance of 60 feet more or less to the northwest corner of Lot 8, Block 6 of Manitowoc Rapids Subdivision; thence easterly along the north line of said Block 6 a distance of 493 feet more or less to the northeast corner of Lot 1, Block 6; thence northeasterly a distance of 65 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

Said tract contains 30,056 square feet (0.69 acres) of land more or less.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc, that the above-described portion of Archer Street is hereby discontinued in conformance with Wis. Stat. 66.1003, with the City and Manitowoc Public Utilities retaining all the rights, title and interest of public utilities in the discontinued street, and the Clerk is directed to give notice of public hearing thereon by Class 3 notice under Chapter 985 Wis. Stats., for which the hearing must be at least 40 days after the date of introduction of this Resolution.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc, that the City of Manitowoc and the Manitowoc Public Utilities reserves all the rights, title and interest of any public utility in, on or over the portion of said street to be vacated and reserved to said public utility of the City of Manitowoc.
