

Good morning Steve,

I forgot to mention it this morning, but just a reminder that I am trying to figure out the process for seeing if money was budgeted in 2020 for the proposed GIS data migration. If not, I wanted to clarify that we would need to go through the CAWG process to have it funded in 2020. As a refresher, the project was described as:

a. GIS Data Migration: ArcGIS Schema and Architecture Consulting Services
The City's GIS schema and architecture is currently using an outdated structure based on
the 2009 GIS Needs and Assessment Plan. With the advent of ArcGIS Server and ArcGIS
Online which allows for publication, the existing GIS structure has become an inefficient
way to utilize the full capabilities of a powerful GIS. The current GIS structure requires
many manual processes that could be automated and reduces the amount of
information that can be shared within the City departments, as well as with the County
and the public. Updating the City's GIS system to maximize the full potential of GIS will
allow for more powerful tools (webmaps, mobile editing, live data, etc.) available
throughout various City departments. The ability to share data and maps with the
public will be more efficient and enhanced.

The expected cost is \$18,000.
