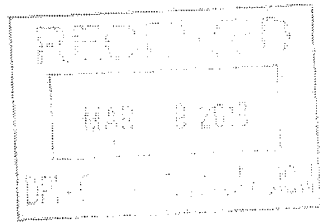

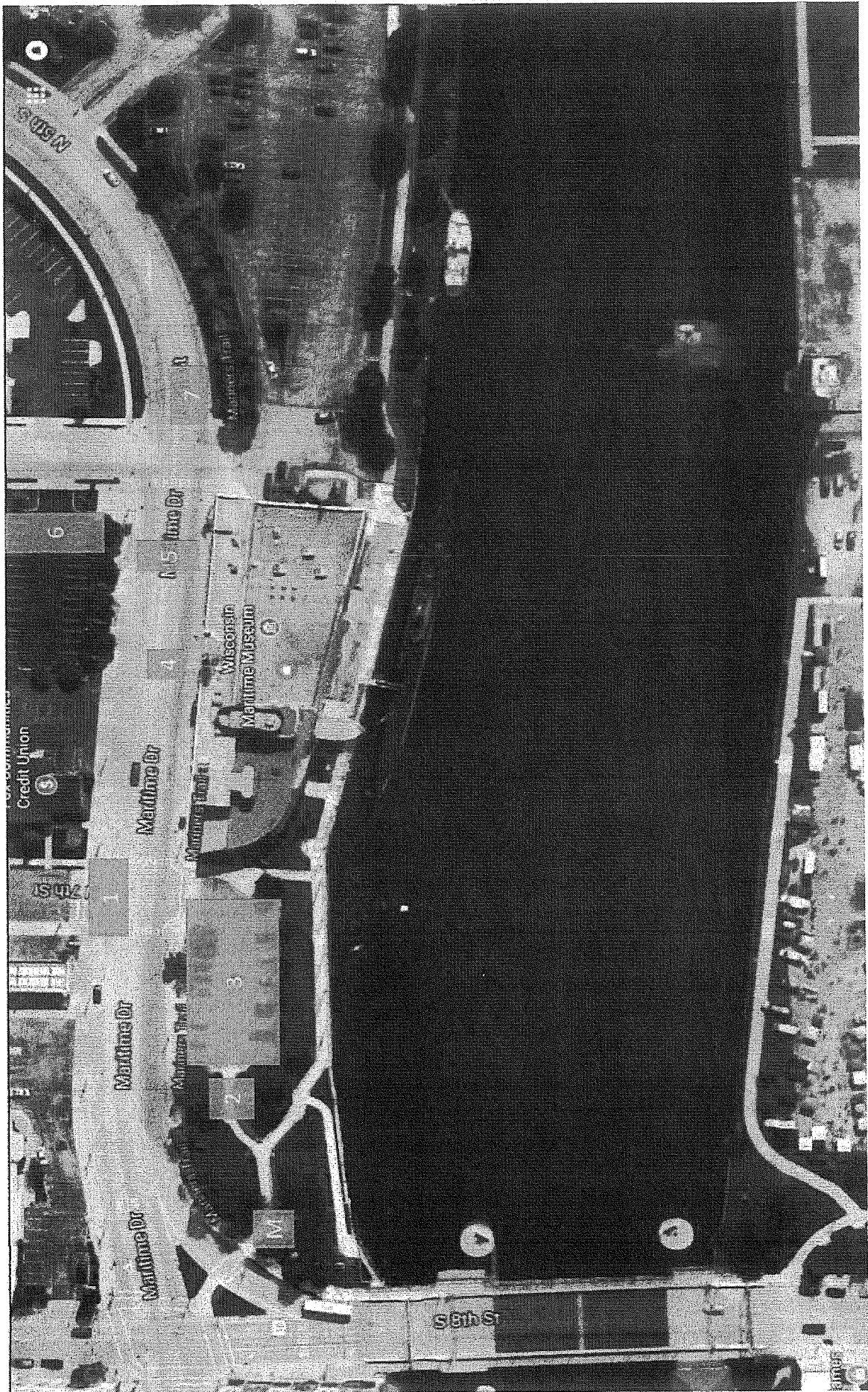

Dear Parks division,

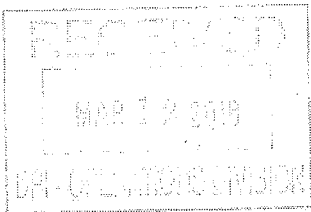
I am helping prepare for Subfest and we are looking at getting some larger tents this year to cover certain areas. To go larger, they would need to be staked into the ground. The one tent that is beyond the size of a stake-less tent would be located in the Shipbuilders Park parking lot. 2 of the 4 sides look like they can go into soil, but the north and east side would need to go into cement or blacktop. I am checking to see which would be preferred, and how we can go about this. The holes would be professionally filled by Rent-A-Tent, a company that takes care of tents for other city events such as Sputnikfest, so I know the city already has an amenable relationship with their company.

In the end, I am checking to see who I need to talk to, and what the requirements are. I see the Stake Permit, and am wondering is it just as simple as filling that out, or more? I see the fee, and can take care of that when needed, just looking for information if I need to do anything else first. My first time working on this portion of Subfest.

Set up / take down and clean up, as well as other services provided by a City staff may be billed on a cost-recovery basis. The event organizer must provide a copy of event liability insurance naming BOTH CITIES as co-insured at least 10 days prior to the event. Permits do not allow "exclusive use" of the trail and the general public must be allowed to share the permitted areas.

This agreement is made and entered into by and between the Cities of Two Rivers and Manitowoc, Wisconsin, hereinafter called "City" and the above-named individual, hereinafter called "Permittee." The parties agree as follows: Bookings must be made no earlier than 12 months in advance. The Permittee understands his/her responsibility is to set up, clean up and restore premises within the time period listed above.

Limitation of Use: Permittee agrees that the number of persons on the rented premises during the rental period shall not exceed the capacity of the facility and that no intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverages shall be served to minors. Permittee agrees to use premises rented for the purpose stated above and no other. In the event this Limitation of Use is not complied with, Permittee shall be charged and agrees to pay a fee of \$200.

Permittee agrees to abide by the rules and regulations contained in this agreement.


12. Legal Notice
