

Cleaning a 10,300 GPH Pump

- 1. Remove the filter sock, and clean any leaves/debris out of it. (If this gets significantly clogged up, it can deprive the pump of water, and burn it out.)
- 2. Take the filter cover off by pulling it out from the main housing.
- 3. Use a screw driver to take out the (4) screws that attach the impeller cover to the main housing.





- 4. Pull the impeller cover off to reveal the impeller, and notice the small dot at the bottom side, that ensures the impeller is placed appropriately back into position after cleaning.
- 5. Pull the impeller out, and clean off any sediment that is either on the cylinder and in the chamber it fits in
