Hi Brentt,

Here is a copy of the proposed plans for the construction of Magnolia Ave.

As we discussed, Magnolia Ave. in this area was never built due to the failed Referendum in 2004 or there a bouts.

However, I would have to guess if the City ever moved forward to build it, I would sure think that these plans would likely be used.

I feel that the Mobilitie pole that is planned for this area should be set with this plan in mind.

I have also attached 2 plan sheets for the intersection at N. 30<sup>th</sup> and Fairmont St. (Federal Mogul/Airport Site).

We would prefer that the pole in this location be located as far away from the curb as possible. I doubt that we will ever see sidewalks on this side of Fairmont St.

I have also attached a drawing for the area at N. 11<sup>th</sup> and Buffalo St. It shows Buffalo St. to have a 70 ft. ROW and a 50 ft. wide pavement.

As always with these drawings, they are "Believed to be Accurate, but not Warranted".

I can also get you something for S. 14<sup>th</sup> St. from Clark to Wollmer St. if we need that one.
