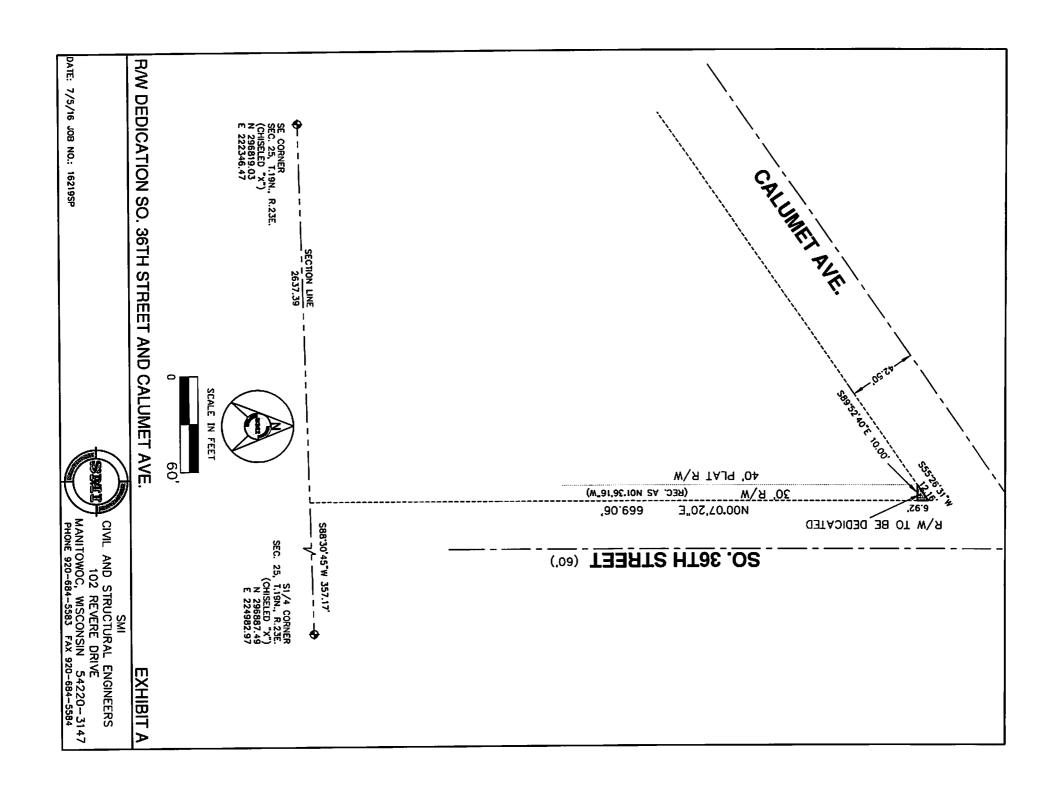

Request: PC 1-2016 Quit Claim Deed - Plenty O Suds, LLC. Steve Benish; Deed for Calumet
