Subject: Fat bike trail in Silver Creek Park

Dan/Jason,

I have been approached by George Kapitz about the possibility of making a groomed fat bike trail in Silver creek park. George and I talked at length about this. I don't think that it will interfere with any of the other uses in this park. George and I agreed with the following plan to get the ball rolling.

- 1) I recommended that George talk with Jim Vanlanen about this because of the disc golf course. George has talked with Jim Vanlenen (disc golf Wisconsin) about sharing the park for disc golf and fat bikes during the winter. Jim is more than happy to share this area with the fat bikes. Jim said that there is a very small number of hard corps golfers that golf during the winter but does not see any issues here. Jim and George are working together to come up with a bike trail map that will not interfere with the disc golfers. I also stressed that he stay away from the sledding hill.
- 2) George will submit a course map and letter of request to me. After I have a chance to look at this and approve it, I will get it on the park and rec committee agenda and council for December.
- 3) The trail would consist of a hard packed snow surface. George has a groomer lined up for the trail. This would be pulled with a snow mobile for grooming. I would work with George on this and anytime that we thought it was too wet or that we would cause damage to the park the trail would not be open.
