

**ORDINANCE**

An Ordinance to amend Section 10.330(1) of the Manitowoc Municipal Code regulating U-Turns, Left-Hand Turns Prohibited – Penalty.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 10.330 is amended to read as follows:

**“10.330 ~~U-Turns~~, Left-Hand Turns Prohibited – Penalty.**

~~(1) There shall be no U-turns at the following places:~~

- ~~(a) Intersection of South 9th and Franklin Streets.~~
- ~~(b) Intersection of South 9th and Jay Streets.~~
- ~~(c) On 8th Street from Waldo Boulevard to Washington Street inclusive.~~
- ~~(d) On Washington Street from 7th Street to 26th Street inclusive.~~
- ~~(e) Intersection of South 26th and Custer Streets.~~
- ~~(f) On 10th Street from Marshall Street to Chicago Street inclusive.~~
- ~~(g) Intersection of 7th and Maritime Drive.~~
- ~~(h) Intersection of 8th and Columbus Streets.~~
- ~~(i) Intersection of Western Avenue and South 23rd Street.~~
- ~~(j) Intersection of 9th and Columbus Streets.~~
- ~~(k) Intersection of 9th and Green Streets.~~
- ~~(l) Westbound Reed Avenue at North 8th Street.~~
- ~~(m) Eastbound Waldo Boulevard at North 8th Street.~~
- ~~(n) Westbound Waldo Boulevard at North 8th Street.~~
- ~~(o) Westbound on Maritime Drive at North 8th Street.~~
- ~~(p) Westbound Waldo Boulevard at North 18th Street.~~
- ~~(q) Westbound Marshall Street at Calumet Avenue.~~
- ~~(r) Southbound on South Rapids Road at Dewey Street.~~
- ~~(s) Northbound on South 42nd Street at Dewey Street.~~

**(2)** Left Turns Prohibited.

(a) Traffic entering South 26th Street from the north at a point 394 feet from the south curbline of Hamilton Street shall be prohibited from making a left turn at said intersecting streets.

(b) Wollmer Street. Westbound traffic on Wollmer Street entering South 21st Street shall be prohibited from making a left turn at said intersecting streets.

**(3)** Penalty. Any person violating any provision of subsection (1) of this section shall be punished by a forfeiture of not less than \$20.00 nor more than \$40.00 for the first offense and for the second or each subsequent conviction within one year thereafter by a forfeiture of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$100.00.”

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall take effect the day after publication.
