Hello

Two Rivers Youth Sports, who puts on the annual Beach Bash, is requesting the use of the Manitowoc Library parking lot for the event. We are requesting the use of the lot starting after business close (8pm) on Tuesday night June 23rd. This would continue through Sunday June 28th.

We are self-sufficient meaning we would not require any power or use of bathrooms. We may need a water hook up for the food truck.

I included a diagram for rough placement. In the Briess parking lot the red area is the stage while the green area is the tent. In the library parking lot, I have that shaded in Blue which will be where the carnival sets up. This isn't your typical carnival; this is a very well-run operation. This company works the state fair, they are family run, very clean and courteous to the grounds they set up on.

We will have port a johns and garbage cans available which we will also have a dumpster for trash removal. There will also be no road closure required for our event.

We realize closing the parking lot to your guests Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday will be an inconvenience to the library. We are keeping the parking lot open in the Briess parking lot, everything shown to the left of the stage (which will be setup early Friday) will be available for parking for guests. We are also willing to give back to the library in the amount of \$400 for the inconvenience (\$100 a day the library is open).

This is our 15th annual Beach Bash in support of youth sports. We are a 501c3 non-profit group giving back to the community. We do draw good attendance as we are a family themed festival. This is a good thing as it will bring many families down to the area to experience downtown Manitowoc and great exposure to the library.
