2. Menasha Ave. – just west of N. 18th St. (Complaint from Citizen)
3. Broadway/Meadow Ln. at Meadow Ct. (Schuette Park).
4. S. 21st and Franklin St.
5. S. 23rd St. – South of Grand Ave. and North of Dewey St.
6. N. 21st St. – near LaFollette Ave. (just north of Waldo Blvd.) (Complaint from Citizen)
7. Waldo Blvd. between N. 21st and N. 23rd St. (Complaint from Citizen)

We have several rough at-grade railroad crossings in the City of Manitowoc.

I see on the OCR website that we are supposed to reach out to the railroad first to see if we can get any resolution before proceeding with the formal OCR petition.

The rough crossings that we have noted and/or have had complaints from the public include:

1. 2 crossings on Custer St. – between S. 26th and S. 29th St. (Complaint from Citizens)
2. Menasha Ave. – just west of N. 18th St. (Complaint from Citizen)
3. Broadway/Meadow Ln. at Meadow Ct. (Schuette Park).
4. S. 21st and Franklin St.
5. S. 23rd St. – South of Grand Ave. and North of Dewey St.
6. N. 21st St. – near LaFollette Ave. (just north of Waldo Blvd.) (Complaint from Citizen)
7. Waldo Blvd. between N. 21st and N. 23rd St. (Complaint from Citizen)

I also contacted Craig Anholt on or about June 23, 2015 regarding the existing rubberized crossings at the 2 railroad crossings on Custer St. See attached e-mail.

Can you check into these crossings and see if you have plans and/or monies available to make some repairs.

Our Public Infrastructure (PI) Committee will be discussing the issue of the rough railroad crossings at their meeting on Tuesday, September 8th at 6:30 pm in the Council Chambers at City Hall. You are welcome to attend the meeting if you are available.

I am not sure whether or not the Committee will want to pursue the OCR route or not.

If you can get me any information/comments before Tuesday night's meeting, it would be appreciated. Sorry for the short notice. Thanks.
