WHEREAS the Manitowoc Common Council did annex territory (Custer #6 Area), and

WHEREAS a recent Attorney General's opinion has indicated that districts set by reapportionment are not changed by annexation in regards to voting,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City of Manitowoc creates Ward Number 33, population two (2), for the Custer # 6 Annexation Area and provides the following boundary description:

DESCRIPTION

Tract "A" of a Certified Survey located in the Northeast ¼ of the Southwest ¼ of Section 26, Township 19 North, Range 23 East, Town of Manitowoc Rapids, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin also described as:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northeast ¼ of the Southwest ¼ of Section 26; thence S. 88° 53' 30" W. along the 1/16th section line, also being the existing City Limits line 152 feet to the point of beginning; thence continue along said 1/16th line 189 feet; thence N. 1° 18' W. a distance of 230 feet; thence N. 88° 53' 30" E. a distance of 189 feet; thence S. 1° 18" E. a distance of 230 feet to the point of beginning.

Said described area contains 43,470 square feet or 0.997 acres of land more or less. (County parcel # 010-026-009-003.00)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Ward Number 33 is combined with the 17th, 18th, 21st, 23rd, 24th, 25th, 26th, 28th, and 32nd Wards for voting purposes and use a common polling place as established for the 9th Aldermanic District, however, separate returns shall be maintained as necessary for the applicable elected offices that require separate returns.
