Since the April meeting was cancelled, I suppose this issue will be on the May meeting agenda??

I do not believe that I would support or recommend stop signs on Cleveland Ave. I think that motorist would either not stop when no one is around or will roll through it. It is not really a location where stop signs are needed. We put up stop signs to control who has the right of way or not.

Stop signs should not be used for speeding problems or other neighborhood reasons.

I am all for the safety of the kids and all pedestrians, but I do not believe that the stop sign is the appropriate solution in this case.

According to the 2011 DOT traffic counts there is only about 1,300 ADT or Average Daily Traffic on Cleveland Ave. That is a rather low traffic volume. See attached count map.

The intersection already has a pedestrian crosswalk and signage on the west side of the intersection. See photos.

Another long term solution might be to reconstruct the intersection of Maritime Dr. and Cleveland Ave. to eliminate the high speed sweeping right turn lane coming off of southbound Maritime Dr. However, this option would have a very high price tag (more than \$100,000).

Another option would be to install a pedestrian bump out at the intersection or even a small traffic circle or roundabout. Just a simple diversion to make traffic slow down and go around an island. This would be a cheaper alternative.
