

RESOLUTION

RECLASSIFY - LEAD INSPECTOR TO INSPECTOR SUPERVISOR

WHEREAS, due to the education requirements and supervisory role and responsibilities of the Lead Inspector position in the Fire Department, Carlson Dettmann has recommended the Lead Inspector position be renamed and reclassified to an Inspector Supervisor; and

WHEREAS, on November 1, 2021, the Personnel Committee unanimously approved to rename and reclassify the Lead Inspector to an Inspector Supervisor position, along with the revised job description of Inspector Supervisor position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc to approve renaming and reclassifying the Lead Inspector position, currently in this role, to an Inspector Supervisor, along with the attached revised job description, as an exempt, salaried position at Grade M, effective January 1, 2022, according to the Compensation Plan and Employee Policy Manual, and subject to the approval of the Mayor’s 2022 Executive Budget.
