Staff was assigned to look at what we could get for \$25,000 for playground equipment at Silveridge, as well as vault facilities and land acquisitions for Camp Vits. C. Scheinoha researched the playground equipment and had some examples from the company that we purchased the equipment in Red Arrow Park from. Mayor Nickels would like to see a policy put in place for use of Parkland Dedication Funds. Committee would like to see some of the Parkland Dedication Fund used. Staff should move forward creating a policy based on what we can and can't do with the fund and include some type of public/private partnership along with a minimum fund balance that should not be gone below until it is rebuilt. The policy should be brought back to the committee. D. Koski is working on a grant for Camp Vits.
