ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to amend Section 15.450(5)(d) of the Manitowoc Municipal Code regulating signs overhanging City right-of-way.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 15.450(5)(d) is amended to read as follows:

“(5) Permits, Applications, Fees, Issuance and Denial, Appeals, Indemnification, Insurance, Remedies.

(d) Signs Requiring an Annual Special Permit. Signs, advertising devices, or canopies which are permitted to extend beyond the lot line and into or over the public right-of-way shall require a special permit from the Building Inspector. This permit requires after paying an annual permit fee for each sign, advertising device or canopy as established by resolution of the Common Council and executing a hold harmless agreement with the City. Said hold harmless agreement shall include an obligation to carry insurance covering the projecting items to pay for public liability insurance on such signs, advertising devices or canopies.”

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect the day after publication.
