Attached is the waiver of fees request for the use of cabin 1. In 2019 and earlier, the group normally met 9 times and paid a reduced rate of \$300 (versus \$1485) for the year to use the cabin in the evenings. A similar request for 2020 was made & approved, but the group only met twice in 2020 and has not paid anything towards that yet. This year, they met in March and are now requesting to meet two more times this year. I had asked Mr. Halverson to indicate what they are indicate they are willing to pay, but he did not indicate an amount on the form and just stated, "Let me know what we owe for those items."

Since their application states that they use revenues for community projects, I'll throw an idea out there that we waive the fees for 2020/2021 if they are willing to donate at least one tree with a 2" diameter or more to be placed in a city park, since we have recently removed dozens of ash trees due to EAB.
