ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to amend Section 10.440 of the Manitowoc Municipal Code setting parking regulations for spring clean-up.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 10.440 is amended to read as follows:

"10.440 Parking Regulations for Spring Clean-Up.

- (1) Duration. The spring clean-up shall be for a period of one week for each section or district. The spring clean-up shall be held in April, Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. The Department of Public Infrastructure will announce any delays due to weather in the same manner in which a snow emergency is announced.
- (2) Maps. The spring clean-up maps shall-be prepared and maintained by the Director of Public Infrastructure and kept on file as public records in the office of the City Engineer, copies of which shall be distributed to the members of the Council and filed with the Council.
- (3)-Sections for Spring Clean-Up. The spring clean-up maps shall divide the City into areas or sections During in which the spring clean-up shall be done as herein specified times set by this ordinance, or otherwise posted by the City, and during which time no vehicles, trailers, boats, dumpsters, or other obstructions shall be parked on the street in a manner which interferes with the pickup of yard waste, Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. for the streets set forth herein, and as more specifically described below:

Property north of the Manitowoc River: Brush pickup shall occur the first week in April and yard waste pickup shall occur the third week in April, weather permitting.

Property south of the Manitowoc River: Brush pickup shall occur the second week in April and yard waste pickup shall occur the fourth week in April, weather permitting.

Section-1: West of North 18th Street and north of the Manitowoc River will be picked up the first week in April, unless weather conditions prohibit the pickup.

Section 2: West of the Canadian National Railroad Tracks and south of the Manitowoc River will be picked up the second week in April, unless weather conditions prohibit the pickup.

Section-3: East of the Canadian National Railroad Tracks and south of the Manitowoc River will be picked up the third week in April, unless weather conditions prohibit the pickup.

Section-4: East of North-18th Street and north of the Manitowoc River will be picked up the fourth week in April, unless weather conditions prohibit the pickup.

(53) Citations. Citations will only be issued if a motor vehicle, trailer, boat, dumpster or other obstruction is parked in a manner which interferes with brush or yard waste pickup."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after publication.
