ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to revise Section 17.090 of the Manitowoc Municipal Code regulating lead water services.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 17.090 (3) is created to read as follows:

"17.090. Additional Requirements

(3) Water Services and Private Water Mains Construction Materials. Water service laterals and private water mains from the public water main in the street to the curb stop shall be of ductile iron, PVC, PE or of Type K copper materials, as set forth in Wis. Adm. Code SPS Chapter 384.

When it appears that a lead or galvanized water service has failed, it shall be replaced with ductile iron, PVC, PE or of Type K copper, from the main in the street to the curb stop; provided, however, that water services damaged by the water utility during disconnection for nonpayment or a water bill may be repaired rather than replaced.

When it appears, upon inspection, that a lead or galvanized water service lateral has failed from the curb stop to the building control valve, the lateral shall be replaced by a lateral of materials as set forth in Wis. Adm. Code SPS Chapter 384."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect the day after publication.
