Dear Chairman and Members of the City of Manitowoc Public Safety Committee,

We jointly and respectfully request the removal of the no parking zone directly adjacent to the property owned by the Alano Society of Manitowoc at 404 S. 29th Street and immediately across the street from the Manitowoc Public School District (MPSD) Central Office.

We believe that this no parking designation is archaic and was put in place to accommodate a small loading dock and its one-time articulating truck traffic when the school district facility was owned and operated by a local manufacturer.

Both the Alano Society and the school district have occasional need for the parking spaces that must remain vacant due to the current no parking zone. MPSD hosts its regular school board meetings at the S. 29th Street administrative facilities, and the Alano Society occasionally hosts special events, where parking in this area would be much appreciated by local citizens.

Representatives of both of our organizations would be happy to appear at any meetings necessary to facilitate a positive response to our request.
