

ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to amend Section 10.390 of the Manitowoc Municipal Code regulating Parking.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 10.390 is amended to read as follows:

“10.390 Parking Prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to park such vehicle in any of the places where parking is prohibited by Wis. Stat. Ch. 346, except to comply with the directions of a traffic officer or traffic control signal or sign, or to park upon any portion of the following designated streets or places:

...

Bayshore Drive.

- (a) There shall be no parking on the east ~~both~~ sides of Bayshore Drive from the ~~east~~ north curbline of the Waldo Boulevard roundabout to the ~~west~~ south curbline of East Reed Avenue.
- (b) There shall be no parking on the west side of Bayshore Drive from the north curbline of the Waldo Boulevard roundabout for a distance of 380 feet to the north.
- (c) There shall be no parking on the west side of Bayshore Drive beginning at a point located 470 feet north of the Waldo Boulevard roundabout and continuing for a distance of 90 feet north.
- (d) There shall be no parking on the west side of Bayshore Drive beginning at a point located 700 feet north of the Waldo Boulevard roundabout and continuing for a distance of 105 feet north.
- (e) There shall be no parking on the west side of Bayshore Drive from the south curbline of East Reed Avenue to 150 feet south of the centerline of Bay Pointe Road.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after publication.
