

**ORDINANCE**

An Ordinance to amend Sections 15.330(2) and 15.550(3) of the Manitowoc Municipal Code to allow ammunition manufacturing as a permitted use in I-1 Light Industrial Districts and remove reference to it in I-2 Heavy Industrial Districts.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 15.330(2) is amended and subsequently renumbered to read as follows:

**“(2) Specific Uses Permitted.** Land shall be used and buildings shall be erected, altered, enlarged, or used for only one or more of the following uses, subject to the provisions of this section and other applicable sections of the Zoning Ordinance:

- (a) Any use permitted in the “C-1” Commercial District except residential;
- (b) Airports;
- (c) Agricultural implement and equipment manufacture;
- (d) Ammunition manufacturing and storage on a minimum of 25 acres and subject to applicable federal and state regulations;
- (~~e~~) Artificial limb manufacture;
- (~~f~~) Bag cleaning;
- (~~g~~) Bakery, wholesale;;
- .....”

**Section 2.** Section 15.350 is amended to read as follows:

**“(3) Conditional Uses Permitted.** The following uses are permitted subject to MMC 15.370(27):

- (a) Acetylene and other gas manufacture and storage;
- (b) Acid manufacture;
- (c) ~~Ammunition,~~ Fireworks, explosive and match manufacturing and storage;
- (d) Asphalt manufacturing or refining;
- (e) Automobile wrecking, dismantling and storage of motor vehicle parts;
- ...”

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall take effect the day after publication.
