RE: Cemetery Lawnmower from Perpetual Care Fund

Members of the Public Infrastructure Committee:

I am writing this memo to ask that you consider allowing us to replace a cemetery lawn mower with money from the perpetual care fund. The cost of the new riding lawnmower is \$23,021.00. We could get \$11,120.00 in trade in for our present mower if we trade it in now. This would result in a net cost of \$11,901.00.

Conducting this transaction now versus next year will save us money and will also give us less of a chance for breakdowns this winter, as we use this piece of equipment with a blower attachment for snow removal as well.

This item was addressed at CAWG, and it was suggested that we take it from this fund balance.
