

St. Croix County Sheriff's Office saves thousands and stays under budget with new fleet plan.

BACKGROUND

Location: Hudson, WI
Industry: Government
Total vehicles: 20 vehicles

THE PROBLEM

St. Croix County Sheriff's Office was accustomed to purchasing used vehicles from local sources. The majority of their vehicles already had 20,000 – 30,000 miles when purchased, which ultimately cost more in operating expenses compared to a new vehicle. Additionally, at the time of purchase, the Sheriff's Office wasn't taking advantage of available government acquisition incentives, and their vehicle selection was limited to what was available at the time.

THE SOLUTION

Each vehicle in the department now has a specific term and cost strategy based on the vehicles' annual mileage, which allows the department to replace vehicles at the optimal time to keep costs down.

THE RESULTS

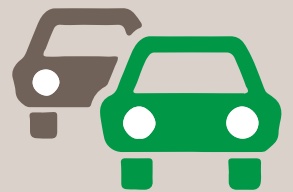
