

**RESOLUTION**

**ELECTION WORKERS' COMPENSATION FOR 2025**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc that each election board official serving at the various elections to be held in 2025 be paid the sum of \$140.00 per election served, and the person delivering the returns (Chief Inspector) shall receive an additional \$40.00 per election served; that each election official who attends the instructional meetings for the voting machines be paid the sum of \$15.00 as provided by law; that Special Voting Deputies be paid at the rate of \$8.00 per hour, or a minimum of \$10.00, plus mileage as determined by City resolution; that the members of the Municipal Board of Canvass be paid \$8.00 per hour; that Voter Registration Deputies, if required, be paid at the rate of \$8.00 per hour, plus the sum of \$15.00 for attending an instructional meeting; and that election officials attending Chief Inspector Training be paid the sum of \$10.00 for the first hour and \$5.00 per additional hour, plus mileage for out of town travel as determined by City resolution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that each member of the Municipal Board of Absentee Canvassers serving at Central Count at the various elections to be held in 2025 be paid the sum of \$180.00 per election served, and the Central Count Election Inspectors shall receive \$140.00 per election served.
