ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to amend the Deposit Schedule for violations of Section 7.210(3) of the Manitowoc Municipal Code regulating snow removal and deposits.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Deposit of Snow or Ice on Streets Prohibited.. If anyone violates Section 7.210, the snow and ice removal ordinance, the standard deposit shall be as follows:

Offense Number (within 12 months)	Deposit Amount	Total Amount with Court Costs
First Offense	\$500 \$50.00 \$200.00	\$124.00 \$313.00
Second Offense	\$750 \$75.00 \$200.00	\$155.50 \$313.00
Third Offense	\$1000 \$100.00 \$200.00	\$187.00 \$313.00
Fourth Offense	\$200.00 \$200.00	\$313.00 \$313.00

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication.

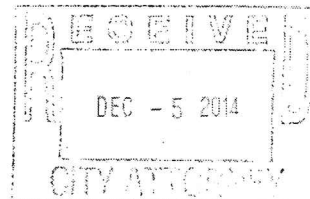
